(For ages 0-2 years)


Our new Baby and Toddler Summer Reading Program is designed to help you have fun reading and learning with your young child!

Each circle describes something you can do with your baby or toddler. Start at the beginning and do one activity every day. Mark off the circles as you go. When you've finished seven circles, come in to the library and your child will receive a sticker and a stamp. When you've finished all the circles, your child will receive a free board book!

All the activities on this sheet build important early literacy skills! Activities (clockwise from top left):

- Read for 10 minutes
- Sing a song to your baby
- Read for 10 minutes

- Read for 10 minutes
- Look at a word book together
- Read for 10 minutes
- Recite a Mother Goose poem
- Read for 10 minutes
- Sing the ABC song

- Tell a story from your childhood
- Read for 10 minutes
- Point out the title of a book
- Read for 10 minutes

- Say the shape of some toys
- Read for 10 minutes

- Read for 10 minutes
- Name all the food on your baby's plate
- Read for 10 minutes
- Make up a rhyme with your baby's name
- Read for 10 minutes

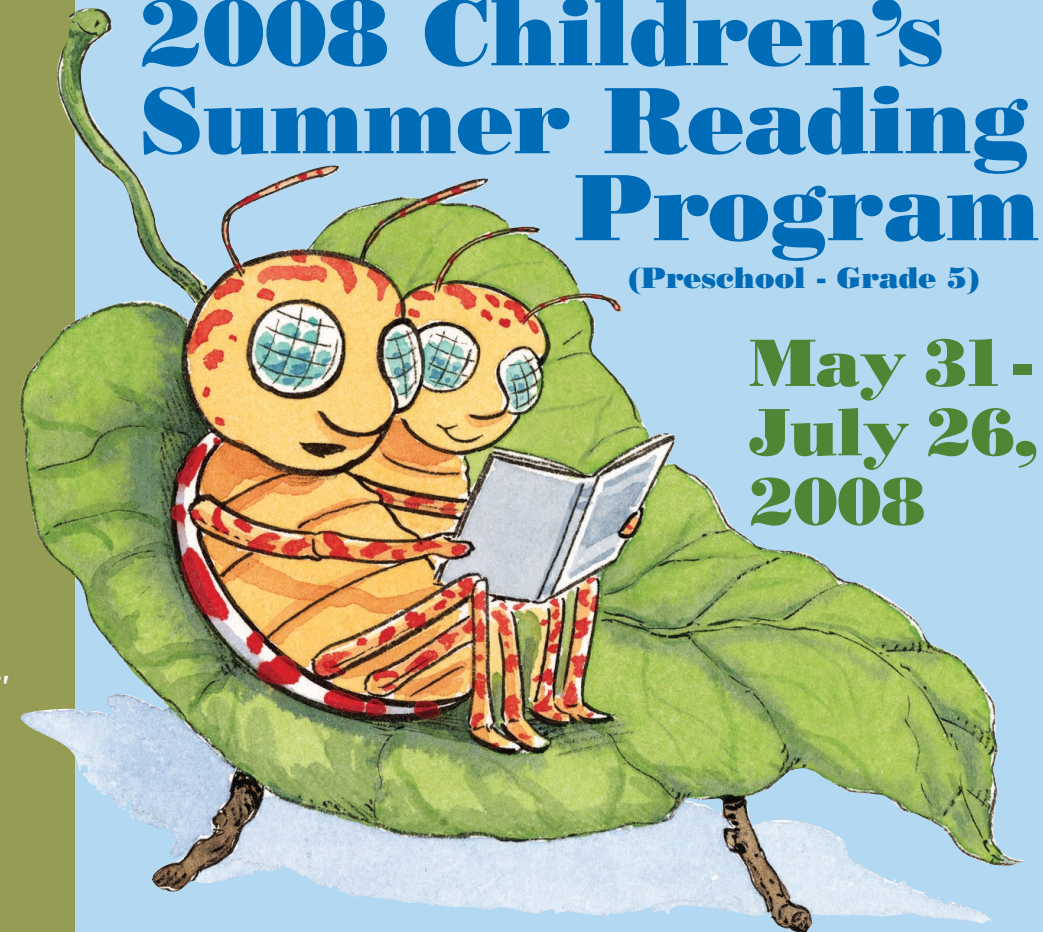

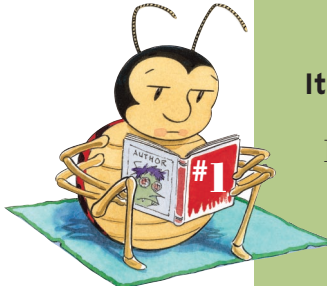

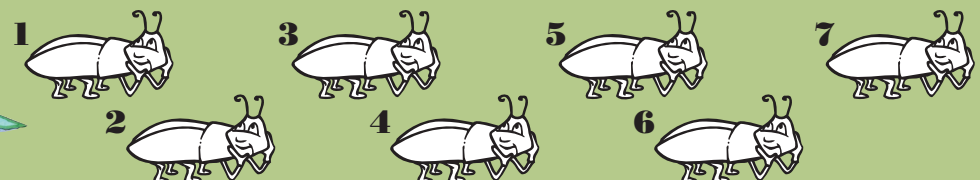

Days of Reading

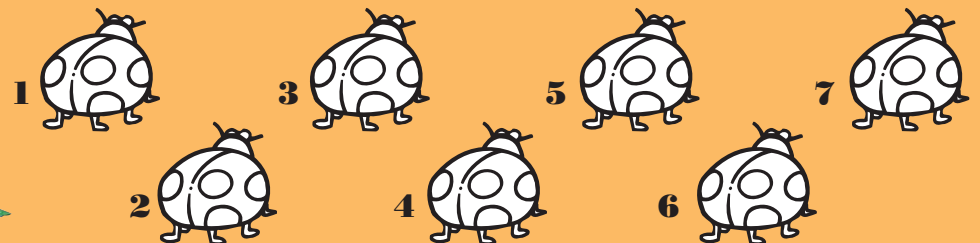
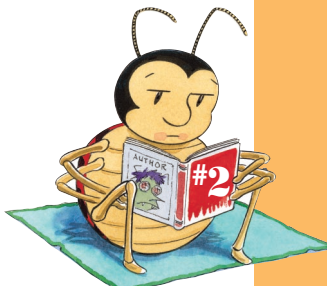
It is recommended that you read an average of 15-20 minutes each day.

Funny bug tattoo, colorful creepy crawler, Nickel-A-Play coupon, Skate City coupon and a chance to enter the weekly drawing.

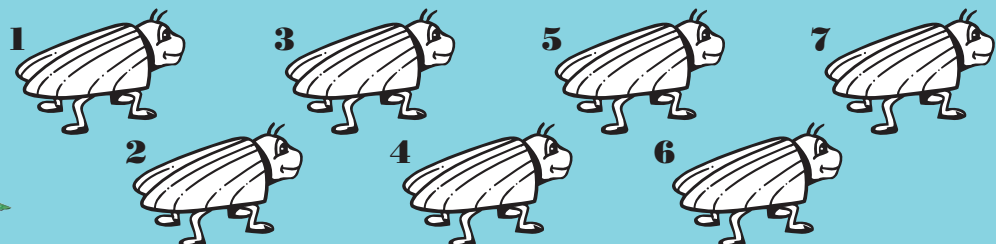
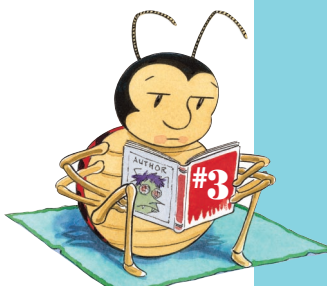

Googly eye finger puppet, Lakeside coupon and a chance to enter the weekly drawing.

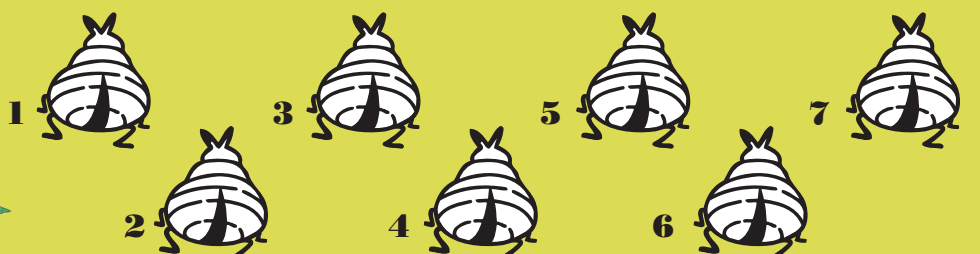
This prize is available from June 13 through July 26, 2008. All prizes must be picked up by July 26.

A book, South Suburban ice skating coupon and a chance to enter the weekly drawing.

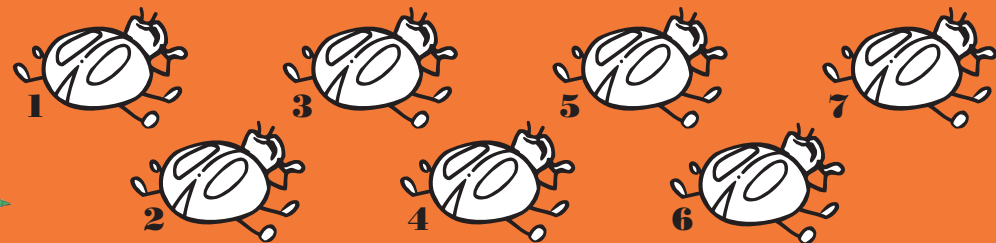
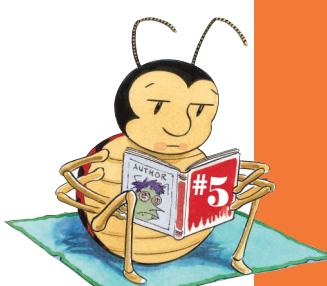

A sticky butterfly, Chipotle coupon and a chance to enter the weekly drawing.

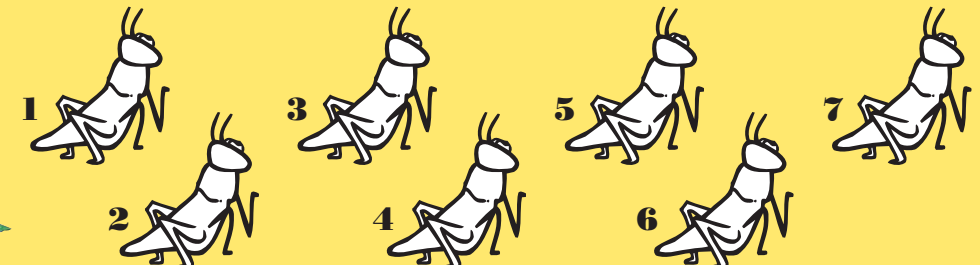
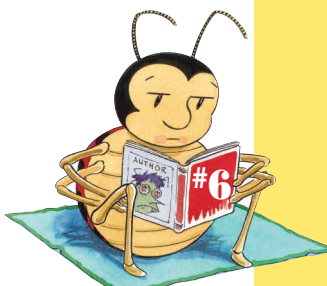

This is your personal Reading Tally. Keep it all summer as you read and earn prizes.

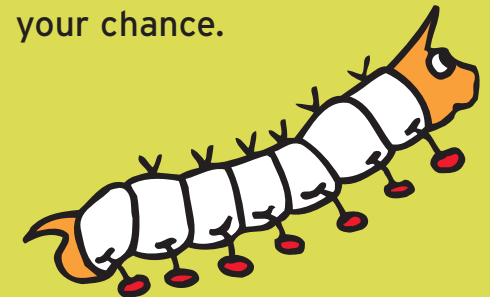
1. For each day that you read or have someone read to you, fill in a symbol (there are seven symbols leading to each prize). Start with Prize #1 and fill in one symbol after your read each day. Don't worry if you miss a day, just keep going to the next day.

2. When you have filled in all seven symbols for Prize #1, bring your Reading Tally to the library to get it stamped and collect your prize. Fill out the weekly drawing you got with your prize and put it into the drawing box.

3. Continue reading each day and fill in the symbols for Prize #2. When you complete all seven symbols, bring your Reading Tally to the library and collect your prize. There are six prizes you can earn this summer and you have a chance each week to win a Buggy Fun Kit.

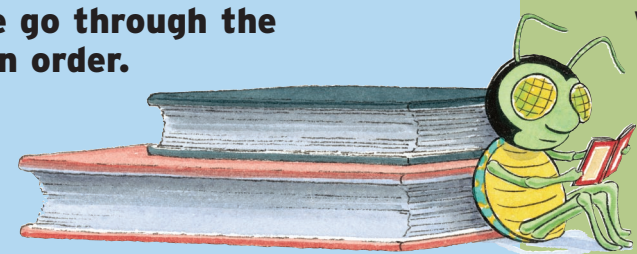
4. Follow the same procedure for Prize #3, Prize #4, Prize #5 and Prize #6. **Please go through the tally in order.**

If you have earned all six prizes, keep reading for additional chances at weekly drawing prizes. You must read for seven days for each chance. The last entry must be submitted by July 26, 2008. Just fill in a caterpillar segment for each day you read and bring your tally to the library to collect your chance.
